

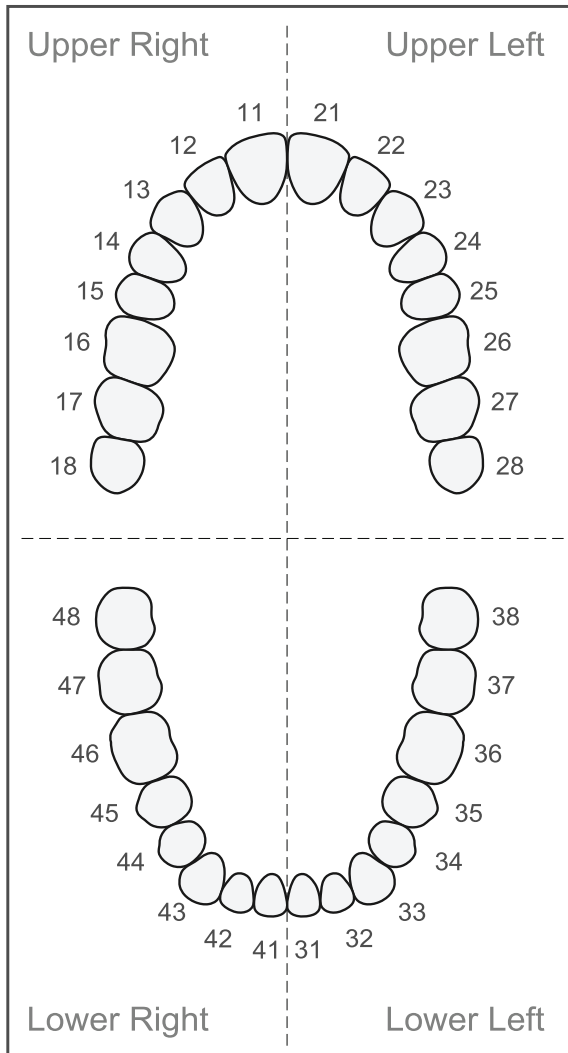


What is tooth numbering?

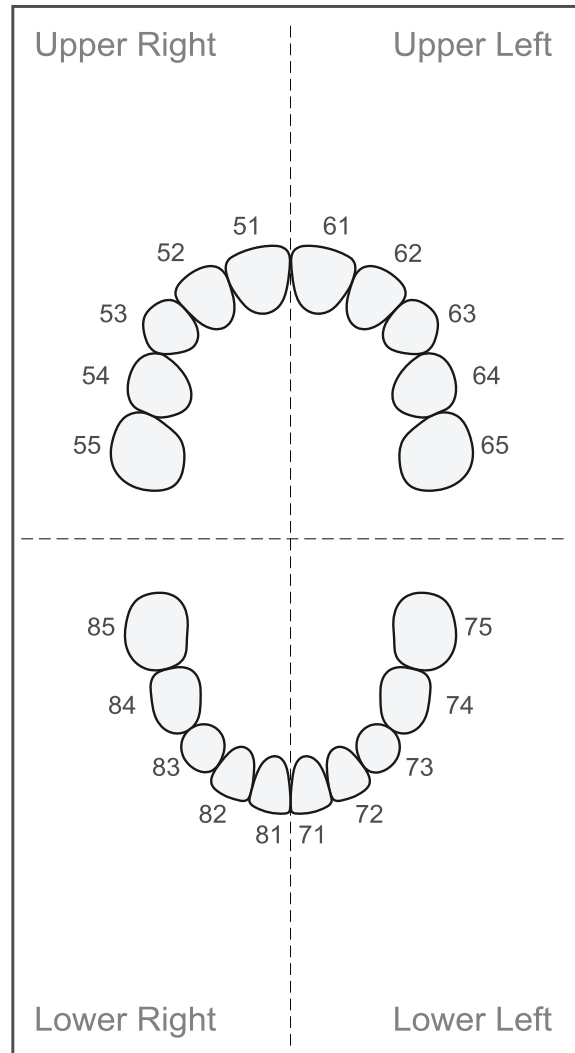
Tooth numbering is used by dental practitioners to identify and provide specific information linked with a particular tooth. The chart below allows dentists to quickly and easily communicate with each other and to a patient about their teeth and what they can do to keep them healthy.

A handy guide to this numbering system is provided below.
